## CAMPAIGN GOAL WITHIN REACH— MAKE A GIFT TODAY

**W**ith the chapter house remodel done and the Beta celebration weekend of our 125th anniversary on the UNL campus a pleasant memory, we still have many great things to look forward to at Alpha Tau.

This spring, 32 new initiates were added to our chapter, and several Lincoln alumni opened their doors to pledges and their pledge fathers during initiation week.

While there has been recent negative news about another UNL fraternity, there was also a very positive article written about our chapter in *The Daily Nebraskan*. We assure each of you that our undergraduates and the Alumni Advisory Board work very hard to prevent problems from happening at Alpha Tau. What is not done is our need for fundraising efforts. The giving totals are outlined on pages 2 and 3. We have surpassed \$2.7 million, and, through another alumnus who has agreed to match pledges, we are that much closer to reaching our \$3 million goal.

Each alumnus recently received a letter from us asking for your support. **We still need it.** It is easy to look at the completely renovated house and think that no further support is necessary, but

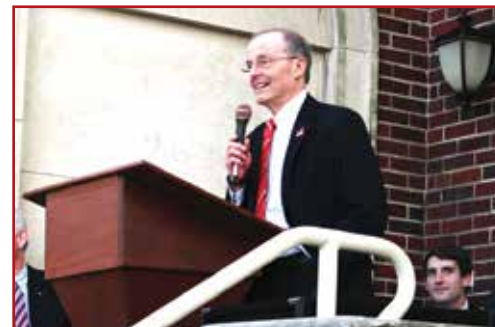
that is not the case. We have paid the contractors, and are using a loan for the remaining balance. We have received almost \$1.6 million of what has been pledged. (Remember, pledges can be spread over a five-year period.) The remaining balance is incurring interest expense from our loan. You can help Alpha Tau remain financially sound by increasing your existing pledge, or paying your pledge in full now. To date, 58% of donors have paid their pledges in full, and for that, we thank you.

**We're only \$400,000 away from reaching our goal.** It may sound like a lot, but it is definitely within sight. Look back at your Beta experience, and how Beta and Alpha Tau helped your success after college. We realize many of you have different views, but all of us can point with pride to the friendships we have made. Look into your heart, and return the enclosed pledge form with your pledge or contribution today.

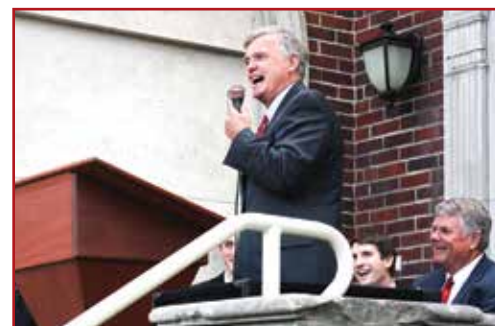

## Academics and Recruitment Continue to Excel

The past few months have been an exciting time for the Alpha Tau Chapter at 1515 R Street. Thanks to the support of hundreds of alumni, actives, and friends of Beta, our 125th anniversary celebration in November was a huge success. The members strive to continue their excellence in academics, intramurals, philanthropy, and leadership roles on campus while enjoying the comfort of a newly renovated chapter house.

### Alpha Tau Remains Strong in Academics

Beta Theta Pi recorded a 3.471 GPA for the fall 2013 semester, which ranks second among fraternities behind Beta Sigma Psi. This marks the seventh-straight semester placing in the top two in GPA among fraternities.

### Chapter Gives Back through Philanthropy

This spring, we have numerous philanthropy events scheduled. In addition to our annual Burrito Bash philanthropy benefiting Lighthouse, we are participating in Cardiac Arrest (benefiting cardiac care) with Alpha Phi Sorority, and Backpack in Black (a concert benefiting the backpack program for the Food Bank of Lincoln) with Farmhouse and Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternities.

### Beta Initiates 32 Members

We initiated 32 men into our chapter in January and are impressed with their growth. Of this total, Alpha Tau raised \$10,622 from the chapter and supportive alumni. Our thanks to all.

The active chapter cannot thank our alumni enough for their support, especially with the capital campaign. We've enjoyed the communication with alumni this past year, and we hope to keep the connection going this semester and for years to come.

# A Look inside Alpha Tau's Recruitment Process

**R**ecruitment is an ongoing process for the Alpha Tau Chapter. During the spring 2014 semester, applications of potential members are available for Greek chapters to view. Our chapter has a team that consists of the recruitment chairman and other actives. The team reviews all applications and selects individuals to consider based on GPA, ACT scores, high school involvement, and many other factors. In addition, we often obtain recommendations from alumni and active members.

After contacting the potential rushee, they are invited to a recruitment dinner, and then evaluated on their compatibility with our chapter. If we believe they would be a good fit, we invite them to attend one of our barbecues at the chapter house. The entire chapter can then evaluate the individual and give opinions to the recruitment team. After the dinner, barbecue, and opinions from the rest of the chapter, the team makes their final decision. If we think the rushee would be an asset to the chapter, we generally offer him a bid card at the next recruitment event.

This is the general outline of our process. Other events that take place throughout the summer are more spontaneous. Sometimes we'll decide to take rushees to a College World Series game or similar event. There are also lake events that are usually hosted by an active or alumnus. We make certain everything is done in accordance with IFC recruitment policies. One of the newer additions to the process is an event called Greek Getaway. The event allows out-of-state rushees to visit with all chapters that want to participate. We were assured that this is in no way taking a step toward a formal recruitment process, but providing an outlet for rushees to get in touch with more Greek chapters.

We anticipate further information to be provided to alumni in the months ahead. As dates are determined, these will be posted on the chapter website [beta.unl.edu](http://beta.unl.edu). If you have recommendations now, please communicate these for our consideration.
